

## MET1010 Test Instructions

- There will be 5 exams during the term plus a final exam at the end of the course.
- The lowest of the 5 exam scores will be dropped.
- All the exams will be multiple choice and will be machine graded. The 5 regular exams will have 30 questions each. The final exam will have 60 questions.
- Bring several #2 pencils and a good eraser to each test.

## Questions

- No penalty for guessing, so don't leave any answers blank.
- If a question has a "fill in the blank," write answer on question sheet and look for the answer in the multiple choice list.
- Some questions ask, which statement is FALSE? Mark T by the ones you know are true, F by false, and "?" if you're not sure. Pick best answer.
- No intentional trick questions. If question unclear, raise your hand, and I'll come to you to clarify the question.

## Best wishes for test!

- After finishing, proofread carefully. Almost every test, at least one person leaves at least one answer blank.
- You may turn in your paper and leave as soon as you are done.
- Student ID will be required for each quiz.
- Be patient when turning in your paper. We have to check IDs and sort the exams into the different forms.
